This changed after the War. In his Inaugural Address in 1949, the American President, Harry Truman, announced a "bold new programme for making the benefits of our scientific advances and industrial progress available for the improvement and growth of underdeveloped nations" (the so-called "Point IV" Plan). At that time it was thought that this support would be needed only for a limited number of years, comparable to the Marshall Plan assistance to Europe. Major donors applied structural adjustment policies; some called this the lost decade (*década perdida*). The form of aid changed from projects to programmes and budget support. Describing the different aid forms of the last 65 years and analysing why aid changed from time to time are the subjects of this book.
