Mary also sent messages to government and church leaders to instruct them how to end the ethnic hatred simmering in their country. But the story still remained largely unknown. Now, however, Immaculée Ilibagiza has changed all that. She has made many pilgrimages to Kibeho, both before and after the holocaust, has personally witnessed true miracles, and has spoken with a number of the visionaries themselves.
